Our desire as a church is to do everything possible to equip parents to disciple their children towards a clear understanding of the gospel, God's work of conversion, and the evidences of grace that are present in the life of a believer.

We believe that conversion, baptism, church membership, and communion are all important elements in building spiritually healthy people. Therefore, we have developed a process for bringing all of these elements together for children in elementary school through the 8th grade.

What will the process do?

Help Parents - This process helps parents by letting them take the lead in the discipleship of their children and equipping them with resources to do so. It also helps them to discern God's work of conversion in the life of their child.

Help Children - This process helps children by letting them hear the Gospel clearly, and learn healthy patterns of discipleship. It also helps protect children from false security and future doubts that may arise from a weak discipleship process.

Help the Church - This process brings together conversion, baptism, church membership, and communion for everyone while developing healthy disciples.

How does the process work?

When your child is expressing deep interest in salvation and baptism or has indicated that they have come to repent and place their faith in Jesus, you should contact the appropriate staff member (Josh Hussung for youth or Jason Miller for children) concerning the baptism preparation process.

The staff member will arrange a meeting with you and your child to discuss your child's desire to be a follower of Christ. A discipleship resource will be provided for you to walk through with your child in order to help them develop healthy habits of discipleship. A new member class for children will be provided to help your child understand the connection between their faith and membership in the local body of believers. A church covenant will also be sent home to be completed and returned by your child. Once the elders have received and approved this covenant, baptism can be scheduled.

FAQ's

What if my child is already baptized?

If your child has already been baptized by immersion as a believer in Christ, contact the appropriate staff member to discuss how to proceed in pursuing church membership.

Should my child take communion?

For the purpose of discipleship, we ask that children wait to take communion until after they have completed the process and have been baptized.

Once my child is a member, will he or she be able to vote?

Voting eligibility for members at Grace begins upon entering the 9th Grade.

What happens if we determine through the process that my child is not ready?

We realize that every child is unique and that God's timing is not the same for everyone. Because of this, we will work with you to determine what action is best for your child.

My child is not yet ready for the process. Are there any resources that can help me think about this in the meantime?
